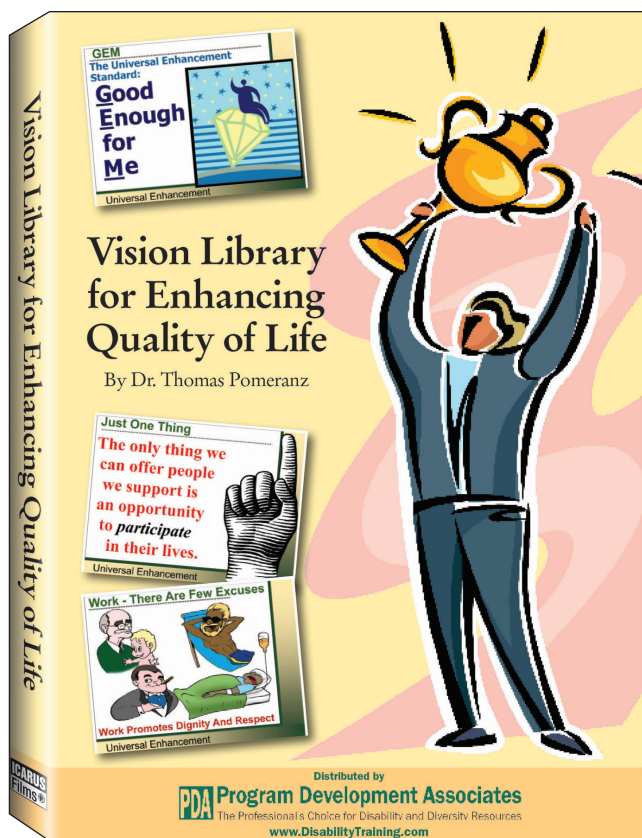

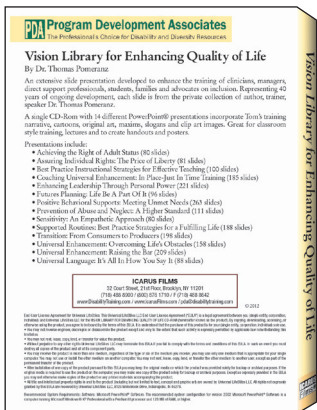

Positive Behavioral Supports: Meeting Unmet Needs

Dealing with anger and its consequences is one of the most difficult challenges we face in supporting people with developmental disabilities.
